

FINs MISSION

Fishing in Neighborhoods (FINs) is a program that was created to bring fishing opportunities near cities of all sizes throughout the state of Kentucky. Each lake within the program receives a regular stocking of catfish and rainbow trout. The lakes will be regularly sampled and anglers' needs assessed to ensure lakes are meeting the needs of anglers. Stocking of sunfish and/or largemouth bass will occur if needed.

*Floyds Fork stockings occur at I-64 in Beckley Creek Park, Sara and W.L. Lyons Brown Bridge in Beckley Creek Park, Pope Lick Bridge in Pope Lick Park, Cane Run Paddling Access, and Seatonville Road Bridge in Turkey Run Park, with 400 trout stocked at each site.

Boulder Pond in Turkey Run Park is not part of the FINs program, but is stocked with trout in October and March.

CATFISH

William F. Miles Wood Duck Lake and Snapping Turtle Lake are stocked with catfish every other year.

SEASONAL REGULATION

Trout in Floyds Fork are under a seasonal catch and release regulation from Oct 1 through Mar 31. During the catch and release season, only artificial baits shall be used, and all trout caught must be immediately released.

**Daily creel limits on catfish and sunfish apply to all William F. Miles Lakes only, these limits do not apply to Floyds Fork or Boulder Pond. Creel limit for trout at Boulder Pond is 8; creel limit for trout on Floyds Fork is 8 after catch and release season ends.
