### FINS MISSION

**Fishing in Neighborhoods (FINs)** is a program that was created to bring fishing opportunities near cities of all sizes throughout the state of Kentucky. Each lake within the program receives a regular stocking of catfish and rainbow trout. Lakes will be regularly sampled and anglers' needs assessed.
