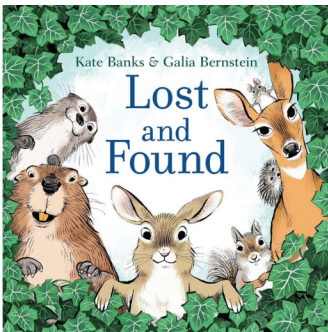


StoryWalk®



Walk a trail & read a tale!

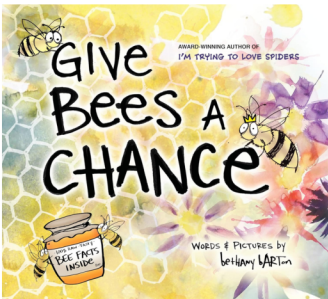

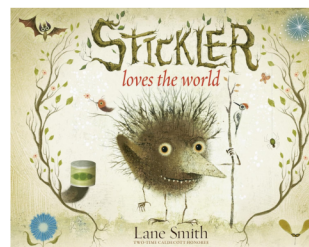

Laminated pages from a children's book are attached to temporary signs, which are installed along an outdoor path. As you stroll down the trail, you're directed to the next page in the story. On the back of the signs, you will find more information and activity prompts. StoryWalks® have been installed in 50 states and 13 countries.
